weather Code Red Notification System

Code Red is the City of Waterloo's emergency and general information notification system. With the Spring storm season close ahead, we would like to send out a reminder to sign up for these notifications, if you haven't already.

You are able to select what type of weather notifications you would like to receive: tornado, severe thunderstorm and/or flash flood. The weather notifications are sent out by the National Weather Service and you will only receive notification when the address you register is within the warning area. Please note that you will not receive weather notifications unless you opt-in to receiving these notifications. You also have the ability to receive notifications via text message or email.

By opting in to this notification system, you will also receive important messages from the City of Waterloo regarding happenings such as planned electrical outages, boil orders and changes in trash pickup.

McKendree Classes at City Hall
