## Accessory Structures

The City of Waterloo would like to remind its residents that all accessory structures (including storage sheds, garages, carports, decks and greenhouses) that are over 50 square feet in size require a building permit before construction may take place. Resin sheds over 50 square feet are not permitted.



## New "Special Event" Permit

Recently, the City of Waterloo made a change to city ordinances regarding Special Events. It is now required to obtain a Special Event Permit 30-days prior to such event being held, along with providing Proof of Liability insurance. If you or an organization you belong to hosts an event, please visit our website to review the definition of a special event and procedures for obtaining the required permit.
