Agenda Item 1, Citizen on non-agenda items: None.

Agenda Item 2, Approval of 08-14-14 minutes. Motion to approve made by Steve Notheisen, second by Vicki Koerber, 5-0 vote to approve.

Agenda Item 3. Getting Settled Guide. Sarah Deutch presented information on renewal of advertisement. Cost of ¼ page ad is \$550, same as last year and budgeted through Community Development fund. Motion to approve made by Steve Notheisen, second by Russ Thomas, vote 5-0.

Agenda Item 4. Map Ads. Cost of center page map ad in Tourism Times is \$500. Motion to continue ad made by Russ Thomas, second by Steve Notheisen, vote 5-0. Paid from Tourism Tax fund.

Agenda Item 5. Chester Billboard. Rental renewal in February. Motion made by Steve Notheisen to continue ad for two year contract at \$210 month with new vinyl. Sarah will dress it up, but retain basic message. Charles Metzger seconded motion, approved 5-0. City Council Agenda item.
