Police Committee Meeting September 25, 2017 3:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order with the following in attendance: Mayor Smith, Alderman Hopkins, Alderman Thomas, Alderman Buettner, Alderman Hopkins, Alderman Darter, Chief Mike Douglas, Deputy Chief Jeff Prosise, Shawn Kennedy, and City Attorney Dan Hayes.

- 1. Petitions by Citizens on Non-Agenda Items. None.
- 2. Discussion and Possible Enactment of Drug Policy in the Case of Officer Involved Shooting Resulting in Injury or Deaths as Required by new State Law. Dan Hayes stated that there is a new state statute requiring a policy for police officers involved in a shooting that they submit to drug and alcohol testing. The FOP has requested to bargain the impact of this new state law. Mike Douglas stated that Lexipol will have a new policy in a few weeks that will comply with the new state law.  - b. Discussion on technology and ability to dump cell phone information upon search warrant. City currently relies on another City for this service.
 - c. Discussion on lack of training hours by current police officers.
