

**Sewer and Water Committee Meeting**  
**August 7, 2017 – 6:15pm**  
**Minutes – Stan Darter**

**Meeting Called to Order:** 6:18pm

**Committee Members Present** - Darter- C, Buettner, Hopkins, Tom Smith

**Others Present** – Shawn Kennedy, Tim Birk

**Petitions by Citizens Non-Agenda Items** – None

**Water Leaks** – Shawn Kennedy read a letter from Waterloo CUSD asking for a reduction in Sewer charges. The High School has an “automatic fill” system to keep the pond at a desired level, this system got stuck in the On Position and ran for about 2 months. Water usage was about 1.3 million gallons on the June Bill (normal use would be about 215,000 gallons) and the July Bill will be about the same. This resulted in approximately \$7,500 excess sewer for water that did not go through the Sewer System. The total Credit that could be applied to the Waterloo CUSD Bill would be about \$15,000.

Since there were only 3 Committee members present, Motion was made by Hopkins and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Buettner to table this item until the full committee could meet. Motion passed.

The City also received a written request from a Homeowner with a Pool for a reduction in their Sewer Billing for water not processed through the Sewer System. Alderman Darter received a phone call from another Pool Owner asking for a reduction in Sewer Billing for re-filling his pool because the water was not processed through the sewer.

**Comments** –

Mayor Tom Smith said the City most probably will receive the grant for the Multi-Use Trail from Bulldog Blvd south to Route 3. We received extra points when we changed it from a sidewalk to multi-use trail.

Tim Birk talked about the need for a water line from Waterloo High School to Stonefield Subdivision. This would complete that loop and make the distribution of chlorine more uniform. It would also prevent the need to flush hydrants in Vandebrook at the end of a Line. The new water line would cost approximately \$50/foot.

The final cost for the leak at Lakeview Park on the middle lake levy was \$92K.

Motion was made by Hopkins, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Buettner to adjourn.
