

MINUTES OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 21, 2017

Z-17-12-01 Review and Comment on Petition to consider a proposed Zoning Text Amendment submitted by the City of Waterloo, Il to amend Flags and Flagpoles under Section 40-3-17(A) of the Zoning Code to allow for the temporary addition of a third flag on a flagpole by a local unit of government by a local unit of government in observance of the State of Illinois Bicentennial.

Mr. Jim Nagel, Zoning Administrator, commented that the required public notices were published in the Waterloo Republic Times on November 29, 2017. Mr. Nagel spoke on behalf of the City of Waterloo, explained that 2018 was the bicentennial year of the State of Illinois, and that the city would like to be permitted to fly three flags in observance of the celebration. The city will only fly three flags for the calendar year 2018, and after that time, would like the ordinance to expire at the end of 2018.

Motion was made by Kaempfe and seconded by Mueller to recommend approval for a proposed Zoning Text Amendment to allow for the temporary addition of a third flag on a flagpole by a local unit of government by a local unit of government in observance of the State of Illinois Bicentennial.
