The Santa Float will again make its way through Waterloo, bringing gifts and holiday cheer to all! The City of Waterloo, Waterloo Chamber of Commerce and Sister Cities of Porta Loo, with the help of many continued donations from individuals, businesses and organizations, have come together to make sure this

neighborhood. This year, on the second night of each route, the route will be reversed to give young children that may live at the end of their route a chance to visit Santa. There is a color-coded map and turn-by-turn route directions available to view online at www.waterloo.il.us. The float heads out at 5pm each evening and will be led by a City of Waterloo vehicle with red and green flashing lights and a loudspeaker, so you know Santa is close by. Santa has a treat for all children who come out to see him!

Before the Cold Sets In...

- Check sprinkler or irrigation systems. Make sure you've turned everything off and fully drained the system.
- Identify your home's freezing points. These include pipes in crawl spaces, unheated rooms, basements, garages and exterior walls. Where pipes are exposed to cold, wrap them with insulation or heat tape.
- Know how to shut off your water. Locate your main water shut-off valve and mark it.
