Accepted Recyclables:

- Paper - newspaper & inserts, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, books (hard covers off)
- Aluminum, tin & steel cans - metal food cans, beer & soda cans
- Curragated & single-ply cardboard - please break down boxes
- Plastics - **household plastic containers ONLY** (look for #1 thru #7) no plastic bags!
- Glass jars & bottles - do not include broken glass
