## **"RECYCLE RIGHT" TIP OF THE MONTH**

Learning the "do's and don'ts" of recycling will help more truck loads end up at the recycling center and not in the landfill. Thank you for being informed and recycling right!

Styrofoam can NOT be recycled in the recycling totes, even if it has a recycling symbol on it. No foam packing materials, coffee cups, or takeout containers. Please make sure to remove styrofoam from cardboard boxes before putting boxes in the totes.

Styrofoam can be recycled at the Monroe County Health Department at 1315 Jamie Lane from 8:30am to 4:00pm, Monday through Friday. Clean white particle styrofoam is the only type that

can be recycled. This does not include cups, clamshell food containers, egg cartons, peanuts and any type of soft foam or foam contained in plastic.
