## 2023 IMUA Scholarship

The City of Waterloo, in partnership with the Illinois Municipal Utilities Association (IMUA), is again offering a scholarship competition program for eligible high school seniors. Each eligible applicant is asked to submit an application and an essay of 500 words or less addressing their choice of one of three utility-related questions. The top four will receive a finalist certificate and a \$1,000 scholarship award check from IMUA.

Applicants must be high school seniors whose parents or legal guardians are residential customers of the City of Waterloo Municipal Utility. The deadline for submitting applications and essays is Friday, March 10, 2023. # Vietnam Veterans Day

In 2022, the City of Waterloo joined the United States of America Vietnam War Commemoration as a Commemorative Partner. As a partner, we promise to assist the nation in thanking and honoring our veterans and the nine million families that served during the Vietnam War Era.

March 29th is designated as National Vietnam War Veterans Day. Last year, we held a Vietnam Veterans Day Program on Main Street in downtown Waterloo. This year, a program will be held at the Veterans Memorial at Lakeview Park on March 29 at 11 a.m. We have moved locations, because during this year's program we will have a special dedication of the Vietnam Era soldier statue that was installed at the park in late 2022.

# Acceptable Recyclables

Below is a list of acceptable items for recycling. Recycling totes should be placed curbside by 6:00 a.m. Please rinse recyclables thoroughly. You may visit our website for a list of common contaminants that are not acceptable.

- Paper newspaper & inserts, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, wrapping paper, books (hard covers must be removed)
- Aluminum, Tin & Steel Cans metal food cans, beer & soda cans, aerosol cans
- Cardboard please break down boxes, curragated and single ply (cereal boxes, soda/beer cartons)
- Plastics household plastic containers ONLY (#1 thru #7) beverage containers, milk & juice jugs, dairy products, detergent containers, etc.
- Glass Jars & Bottles do not include broken glass. Glass jars & bottles can also be recycled at the Monroe County Recycling Center - 901 Illinois Ave.
