RELIABLE SANITATION RECYCLING PROGRAM

Reliable Sanitation Service provides curbside recycling pickup for the City of Waterloo. We have heard concerns from citizens as to whether or not the recyclables collected are actually being recycled, and would like to inform you of the recycling process:

After collection, comingled recyclables are transported to Southside Recycling in South County. Upon arrival, the recycling loads are often audited for contaminates. If contamination is excessive, a fine is imposed. Reliable Sanitation is committed to the recycling program, but contamination in the recycling stream is a major problem and prevents Reliable from recycling many loads. This is why it is so important that everyone does their part to



follow the recycling guidelines and do not place contaminates into the recycling bins. Common contaminates include plastic baas, styrofoam, clothes, plastic hanaers, vard waste, construction materials and general household trash. Recyclables also need to be "loose" (not contained in plastic bags) and clean.
