DUSK TO DAWN LIGHTING SERVICE AGREEMENT

The undersigned Municipal Utility Customer desires to have a Dusk-to-Dawn Lighting Service(s) installed at in Waterloo, Illinois. A charge of \$8.00 per month per unit for 150-watt, Hi-Pressure sodium/175-watt mercury vapor/100watt equivalent LED lamps will be applied to each monthly Utility Bill for a minimum two (2) year period. A charge of \$12.00 per month per unit for 250-watt mercury vapor, 400-watt Hi-Pressure sodium and 250-watt equivalent LED light will be applied to each monthly Utility Bill for a minimum two (2) year period. One thousand (1000)-watt equivalent LED lighting fixtures shall have a monthly charge rate of \$20 per month. The charge of \$8 per month, \$12 per month or \$20 per month, as the case may be, will be added to the customer's monthly electric bill and shall become an integral part of said bill. In the event that the customer desires a removal of the unit or discontinuance of the Service, the charges for the remainder of the contract period shall become due and payable. The City of Waterloo Electrical Department will be responsible for making the installation, on existing wood pole structures, furnishing the electricity for the operation of the lamp, and provide all necessary maintenance, including the normal replacement of lamps. The rate specified herein is only valid for the initial two (2) year period of this agreement, and will be subject to change, at the expiration of the two (2) year period, in accordance with revision to the rates adopted by the City of Waterloo The customer shall notify the Waterloo Electrical Department of any interruption to service of the Duskto-Dawn Lighting. The Waterloo Electrical Department will restore service only during regular scheduled working hours and shall, in any event, be under no obligation to do so until 72 hours from the time of notification. In the event the Waterloo Electrical Department is unable to effect repairs, not caused by the Customer, within this period, the Waterloo Electrical Department's only responsibility will be to abate the charges on a pro-rate basis for each day after such 72-hour period in which service is not available. The customer shall remove any obstruction to the installation of the City owned facilities. Trimming of trees to improve the distribution of light shall be the customer's responsibility. Customer shall provide any permits or easements required for the installations and maintenance of the facilities; and permit access to the City owned facilities by the Waterloo Electrical Department vehicles and personnel.
