

# Gas Committee Meeting Minutes

## April 29th, 2021

Attendees: Mayor Smith, Aldermen Notheisen, Thomas, Heller and Trantham. Alderman Darter was not available.

The meeting was called to order at 3:30pm by Chairman Notheisen. There were no petitions by citizens.

Alderman Notheisen presented the committee with a pair of contracts proposed by MRT (Missouri River Transport) pertaining to our natural gas storage program.

The gist of the contract was to change the dates to begin and end storage delivery and begin and end storage withdrawal.

Currently, delivery begins on May 16<sup>th</sup> and continues until November 15<sup>th</sup>. The new contract calls for delivery to run from May 1<sup>st</sup>-October 30<sup>th</sup>.

Withdrawal will now begin November 1<sup>st</sup>- April 30<sup>th</sup>.

The contract was presented to the City on Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup> and was due back by April 30<sup>th</sup>. This did not allow time for the City Council to approve the contract prior to signing, so this meeting was for the Gas Committee to review and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract and get full council approval on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The contract is not controversial and did not inspire debate.

The motion was made to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract by Heller and seconded by Trantham. Motion passed 4-0.

Alderman Notheisen updated the committee on the status of the February gas bill from Symmetry.

At 3:55 Trantham made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Heller. Motion passed 4-0
