## Waterloo Electric Department Commercial/Industrial Customers are Eligible for Cash Incentives for Installing More Efficient Lighting and Equipment

Electric efficiency projects undertaken by a commercial customer of Waterloo's electric utility may qualify for an incentive reimbursement through the Illinois Municipal Electric Agency's (IMEA) Electric Efficiency Program. Commercial, industrial, institutional, local government or non-government (schools, parks, museums, etc.) customers are all eligible to apply.

### **Eligible Projects**

Examples of projects that might qualify include installing more efficient T8, T5 or LED interior or exterior lighting. Additional applications soon will be available for such measures as refrigeration; programmable thermostats; air compressors; and efficient fans and motors projects.

To be eligible for an incentive, applicants must submit a pre-application before starting their electric efficiency project.
