This application must be signed by the applicant or his duly authorized agent, or if the application is being on behalf of a partnership, firm, association, club or corporation, this application must be signed and sworn to by the President and Secretary of said corporation, respectively. All questions must be answered. If any question is not applicable, place the letters "N/A" in the place set forth for the answer in the inapplicable question.
