Group discussion about Non-Food mobile vendors and sponsored/sanctioned events and allowing Private Events Vendors, these must be on listed on Special Event Requests. The Committee recommends wording as follows for ARTICLE X: MOBILE VENDORS

The Committee recommends the addition of a paragraph C be added to S 7-10-3 Permit Required as follows:

Truck Vendor shall mean the selling, bartering or exchanging or the offering for sale, barter or exchange of any tangible personal property upon or along the streets, highways or public places of this municipality or from house-to-house, whether at once place thereon or from place-to-place, from any wagon, truck, pushcart, or other vehicle, or from movable receptacles of any kind, but shall not include the delivery of any item previously ordered or the sale of items along delivery routes where the purchaser has previously requested the seller to stop and exhibit his items; nor shall PEDDLE be taken to include the solicitation of orders by sample where the goods are not delivered at the time the order is taken. Truck Vendor does not include an ice cream truck operator.

Motion made by Notheisen for the above changes, 2nd by Hopkins, Unanimous Yes vote.

Chief Prosise opened a discussion on Fireworks Requests by neighborhoods.

After a lengthy discussion, The Committee recommends Chief Prosise issue Permits in accordance with State Law.
