**1. Petitions by Citizens on Non-Agenda items – None**

**2. WPD Residency Requirements**

Discussion to allow WPD FOP members to live within a 25-mile radius of Waterloo City Hall. This change should allow WPD to attract lateral transfers from neighboring Police Departments. Additional discussion about allowing Officers to take their Squad Car home beyond the City Limits received no support. Exception to this rule, Trin Daws, K-9.  
Motion made by Trantham to extend the current 10-mile radius to 25 miles, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hopkins, unanimous recommendation.

**3. Discussion regarding Automatic Sprinkler System Requirements in the International Building Code Section 903.**

Krebel distributed Section 903 Automatic Sprinkler Systems.  
Ordinance 40-4-10.  
Currently the City of Waterloo and surrounding communities Do Not make any exceptions to this Code. Short discussion with the resulting conclusion that Waterloo would make no exceptions to this Code. Phil Kelley said, cost of life has no dollar amount.

**4. Comment**

Planning and ZBA didn't have an issue with adding Convenience Store as a permitted use in B2.

Planning Commission made no recommended changes to Manufactured Gazebos. We currently get no complaints for these.

Monroe County does not need to apply for a SUP for their intended use on the lot across the street from Monroe County Jail.
