

Minutes of Street Committee Meeting

January 6, 2025, 6:00 pm

Upstairs Meeting Room, City Hall

Meeting called to order at 6:02 pm by Chairman Vogt.

Agenda Item 1: Petitions by Citizens on Non-Agenda Items: None.

Agenda Item 2: Surface Transportation Program – Suballocated (STP-S) Project:

J.R. Landeck presented Public Works' recommendation for the STP-S program for overlaying Lakeview Drive from S. Library Street to the City-County line. This would include a new paved shoulders and mill and overlay of the drive lanes. The shoulder work would be similar to the project the County completed in 2024. The funding split for this program is an 80% Federal / 20% local, with the City also incurring the engineering costs and any right-of-way acquisition. There are no right-of-way acquisitions anticipated for this project. Total project estimate for this project is \$1.25M. These projects are intended for shovel ready projects and would apply to late 2029 construction funding, with a possibility of moving up in line should other projects not be ready when their funding becomes available. Applications for the program are due on February 7th, with an application fee of ½% of 1% of the Federal funding required to complete the project. Matt Buettner motioned to approve this project application, Kyle Buettner seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 3: Proposed Rogers Street North Access Control – Resolution:

J.R. Landeck handed out a draft of the proposed resolution for access control on the Rogers Street North extension was given to the committee for review. An updated cost estimate for the project is \$3M. An update of the project was given, including discussion of various right-of-way acquisition issues that the project is experiencing. The draft resolution will be reviewed.

Agenda Item 4: Comments: Kyle Buettner received complaints about potholes on Eleanor Lane.
