

MINUTES - STREET COMMITTEE MEETING - FEBRUARY 1, 2021 - 6:00 p.m.

Petitions by citizens on non-agenda items - None

HMG representative presented the Morrison Street project study to the committee. The study was discussed between committee members, the mayor, HMG and T. Birk. The mayor requested T. Birk get estimates of concrete vs. asphalt for the street surface.

HMG and T. Birk explained the Moore Street Phase 5 & 6 program. T. Birk advised we still need some frontage property to complete the Phase 5 & 6 right of way.

T. Birk reviewed his list of 2021 street projects with the committee.

Backhoe Purchase: T. Birk presented the need for a new backhoe and advised he intends to trade a 2001 Case backhoe in. After the committee discussed the equipment needed by the utilities it was decided by the committee to waive the bidding process for a backhoe. Ald. Row made a motion to waive the bidding process, Ald. Buettner 2nd and motion carried unanimously.

Discussion - Street committee members discussed moving funds dedicated for oil and chip to upgrade and improve as many alleys in the city as those funds will allow. Ald. Buettner made a motion to divert the funds to improve the alleys, 2nd by Ald. Row and motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Ald. Heller to adjourn the committee meeting, 2nd by Ald. Thomas and motion carried unanimously at 6:56 p.m.
