**CONTRACT FOR ROGERS STREET/ROSE LANE EXTENSION** – T. Birk presented a copy of the DRAFT that Monroe County wrote to join the city and county in the extension of Rogers and Rose. It includes the requirement of 1.1 million dollars from each the city and county to purchase the property needed and start the engineering for the roadways. Motion by S. Notheisen to accept the draft as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by K. Buettner with unanimous vote by the committee to accept.

**VETERANS DRIVE-** T. Birk stated that he is waiting until the new 16" water line is in to the new water tower behind the VFW before Veterans Drive is resurfaced.

**MORRISON AVENUE**- T. Birk stated that he is still waiting for IDOT approval before moving on with Morrison Avenue rebuild. He is hoping for a January 2022 approval from IDOT.

**2022 STREET PROJECTS**- T. Birk passed out the 2022 Waterloo Streets Project proposal and there was discussion on each area of the proposal. The ADA plan for Market Street from Rt. 156 (Front St.) North to Hamacher was discussed. IDOT will pay for roto-milling/paving Market Street but the city must pay for ADA sidewalk along roadway. T. Birk stated that a Change Order was issued for the North Moore Road project near Gibault High School to relocate a sanitary sewer lateral.

**COMMENTS** – J. Hopkins stated he was concerned about the appearance of Main Street in the uptown area. T. Birk stated the roadway is in good condition but the covering applied several years ago is peeling and leaving the roadway looking patchy.
